





# Investment Representative Program

## (Series 7 Guidelines)

### **Course Background**

The Investment Representative designation, certified by the Bahrain Monetary Agency and BIBF, mirrors the National Association of Securities Dealer's (NASD) Series 7 certification required of individuals selling and trading investment products in the United States. The Bahrain Monetary Agency requires that all professionals involved in investment activities be certified as an Investment Representative.

The Investment Representative Program provides comprehensive treatment of a broad range of products, including equity securities, debt securities, options and mutual funds. The program also provides comprehensive treatment of investment banking, securities laws and





regulations, trading procedures, margin accounts, customer accounts and direct participation programs.

Candidates seeking the designation of an Investment Representative must pass a two-part examination in order to achieve the Investment Representative certification.

The Bahrain Monetary Agency requires that all professionals and support staff engaged in investment related activities identified under Bahrain Stock Exchange Board Resolution 2/99, be certified and registered as an "Investment Representative" with the Bahrain Monetary Agency.

## **Training Methodology**

A Study Manual from Securities Training Corporation (STC), Wall Street, New York will be provided prior to the program. It consists of 22 chapters with learning objectives and review quizzes for each chapter. Chapter 22 is followed by a glossary of terms that will be useful throughout the study period and classroom activities. Classroom activity will focus on lecture, discussion, case study, exercises, quizzes and examinations.

STC's training programs are designed to assist students regardless of an individual's prior experience or educational level. However, a good command of the **English Language** is very important as there would be considerable reading and clear comprehension of instructions for quizzes and examinations is but expected. Each phase of the program has been carefully designed to present concepts in a simple manner and logical sequence.
