## Context and Theme:

**Context:** In celebration of International Women's Day (IWD) (8 March 2022), the Sustainable Stock Exchanges initiative has been hosting a bell-ringing ceremony to raise awareness for gender equality in stock exchanges around the world for 9 consecutive years. The SSE has been working alongside the [International Finance Corporation: IFC](#), [UN Women](#), [UN Global Compact](#), and the [World Federation of Exchanges](#) (the "Global Partners") to organize the "Ring the Bell for Gender Equality" (RTB) initiative. Aiming to draw awareness to the crucial role the private sector can play in advancing gender equality to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals and to raise awareness about the [Women's Empowerment Principles](#) (WEPs).<sup>1</sup>

**Theme and Objective:** The theme for RTB 2023 is aligned with the IWD 2023, "[DigitALL: Innovation and technology for gender equality](#)", Which also meets the priority theme for the upcoming 67th Commission on the Status of Women (CSW66), "Innovation and technological change, and education in the digital age for achieving gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls". Recognizing and celebrating the women and girls who are championing the advancement of transformative technology and digital education. Bringing women and other marginalized groups into technology results in more creative solutions and has greater potential for innovations that meet women's needs and promote gender equality.<sup>2</sup>

The [Amman Stock Exchange \(ASE\)](#), alongside the [International Finance Corporation \(IFC\)](#), [UN Women Jordan](#), and [UN Global Compact Jordan \(UNGCI\)](#) are jointly holding an in-person RTB panel discussion, titled: ***DigitALL: Innovation and technology for gender equality: Ring The Bell Jordan 2023.*** This conference-style panel discussion highlights the **link between Gender Equality, the digital gender gap and sustainability**. It will recognize the **contribution of women to the advancement of transformative technology** and highlight some of the **challenges and costs of excluding women from the digital world**. ASE will Invite listed companies to make a public commitment to the Women's Empowerment Principles and promote gender equality listing criteria and gender data disclosure in sustainability reporting. ASE will share the impactful steps it is taking to build more awareness within its network of listed and member companies by promoting and utilizing the WEPs, as a primary vehicle for corporate delivery on the gender equality dimensions of the 2030 agenda and the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The Women's Empowerment Principles (WEPs) are a set of Principles offering
